TERMS & CONDITIONS

Legends: Solo Harp Competition (International Friendship through Harp) is open to harpist of all nationalities (except Singapore) aged 21 and under. Win a chance to perform solo in the Singapore 2019 Harpfest VI and be part of this exciting festival. Participants are required to submit video recording materials for the audition. Multiple winners may be chosen in each age category.

1. There are 4 Composer Categories to be selected from

(A) A. Hasselmans, (B) H. Renie, (C) M. Grandjany, (D) C. Salzedo

* Participants may submit more than one entry for a different Composer Category.

2. Please apply within your Age Group as indicated in application form.

3. Participants are required to play ONE PIECE ONLY from the chosen Composer Category.

Invited Winners would need to apply Harp Festival Pass to perform in the Winners Recital, join awards ceremony and participate in all other Harpfest events and concerts. COMPETITION AWARDS & JUDGING

JUDGES

Three qualified International judges will evaluate audition materials. All results by judges are final.

~ Judges comments will not be disclosed. All decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

~ **Results will be announced by Email on 1 June, 2019.**

AWARD

~ Successful Competition Winners will be invited to perform at the WINNERS RECITAL as part of Singapore HARPFEST VI.

~ Winners will be awarded in various composer categories in order of 1st Prize, 2nd Prize or 3rd Prize, eg.

M. Grandjany (1st, 2nd or 3rd Prize) ~ Category 1 (age 8 and below)

M. Grandjany (1st, 2nd or 3rd Prize) ~ Category 2 (age 9-15),

M. Grandjany (1st, 2nd or 3rd Prize) ~ Category 2 (Age 16-21)

~ **BEST PERFORMANCE AWARD:** During live Winners' Recital, Best Performance award will be awarded to each age category with recommendation by Jury during Harpfest.

GENERAL RULES

~ Only one piece (submitted Competition piece) will be performed at the Winners' Recital. Repertoire cannot be changed.

~ Contestants must perform from memory. No repeats.

~ Only un-edited video can be accepted for the applications.

~ Certificates will be granted to the winners who performed in the Winners Recital only.

~ Certificate Presentation award is on 8 September 2019 in the HarpFest Closing Ceremony Celebration Dinner.

~ Winners who have chosen not to participate in the Winners' Recital for any reason may be disqualified.

~ Harpfest Committee reserved the right to make any changes to the rules, dates and other information related to the competitions

~ Successful Candidates are required to submit headshot photo & short bio for inclusion in program.
